

## The Three Bears – descriptive transcript

0.00 – 0.04 [Audio: A drum roll] The promotional artwork appears on screen which shows a woodland with bears peeking out from behind a tree and a house in the background. 0.04 – 0.06 A close shot shows Mummy bear popping her head out from behind a tree on stage, she says 'Daddy bear?'

0.06 – 0.09 We see both Mummy bear and Daddy bear holding hands on stage as they say 'good morning'.

0.09 – 0.12 Another close shot shows Daddy bear popping his head out from behind a tree on stage, he says 'Mummy bear?'

0.12 – 0.14 A close shot of a small teddy bear is seen on camera, we hear Mummy bear and Daddy bear say, 'baby bear'.

0.14 – 0.17 A close shot shows Daddy Bear slowly lunging towards the camera saying 'paws' followed by a shot of Mummy Bear also lunging towards the camera saying 'claws'.

0.17 - 0.20 We see another close shot of Daddy Bear playing a guitar with baby bear sitting on his lap. We also hear Mummy Bear say 'ready, steady, 1,2,3' as the camera shows her counting with her fingers.

0.20 – 0.37 We hear Mummy bear and Daddy bear singing, whilst a series of clips play that show the adventure the bears go on as they head into the woods to collect interesting things to re-use in their home. Their house is turned upside down by a colourful whirlwind that threatens to sit in their chairs, eat their porridge and sleep in their beds, Goldilocks!

0.37 – 0.47 A still image appears of a list of dates, times and places that The Three Bears are visiting.
