

An Evening with Lord Ian Botham video transcript

[Audio: atmospheric, up-tempo music plays throughout]

The ball hits the batter's leg pad and the umpire points to signal that the batter is out. Ian turns and celebrates with a close-up shot showing further celebrations.

The next clip sees Ian in bat at the top of the footage as he receives a ball from the bowler. The shot widens as he hits the ball for a six. A close-up shows Ian walking away smiling.

Ian is once again bowling as he bowls towards the batter at the bottom of the footage. The ball hits the batter's leg pad and he is called out. The footage focuses on Ian raising his arms in celebration as the crowd in the background celebrate.

The commentator can be heard saying, 'Gone. LBW. And a second wicket'.

Ian is back in bat as he receives a ball from the bowler at the top of the footage. He hits the ball passed the boundary for four runs. He is seen putting his arms and bat in the air as he celebrates.
