

Sara Pascoe: I Am A Strange Gloop video transcript

The video opens with comedian Sara Pascoe on stage as part of a stand-up routine.

“I never wanted to get married. It wasn’t one of my plans. I don’t really agree with marriage. It’s too long isn’t it?”

[Audio: Audience laughs]

The video cuts to a close-up of Sara’s face.

“Forever. Too long. The whole till death thing is very threatening.”

[Audio: Audience laughs]

“You don’t have to do that with other nice things. Oh, do you want some cake? You can only eat this until you die.”

[Audio: Audience laughs]

The camera pans to a wide shot of Sara on-stage before cutting to Sara sitting with a microphone in front of her as she speaks to camera.

[Audio: Music]

“Hello, my name is Sara Pascoe. I’m a stand-up comedian, and I’m very excited because I’m getting ready to go on tour. It’s starting on the 21st of June 2025, going all the way up to March of next year.”

The video goes dark until an unravelling of scrunched paper effect reveals text reading, ‘Sara Pascoe UK and Ireland Tour’ with doodles of butterflies around this.

The video then cuts to Sara on Live At The Apollo doing stand-up, cutting between wide and close-up shots.

“In an ideal world, what I wanted, I wanted to self-fertilize. I wanted to have children that were exactly my genetics so I could show them to my parents and go, see, it was my childhood. They’re fine.”

[Audio Audience laughs whilst music continues to play]

The video goes dark until an unravelling of scrunched paper effect reveals text reading, ‘As seen and heard on Taskmaster, QI, Sewing Bee, Last One Laughing, Weirdos Book Club, Live At The Apollo, Mock The Week and The Last Leg’ with doodles of butterflies around this.

The camera pans back to a wide shot of Sara sitting with a microphone in front of her as she speaks to camera once again.

“It’s called I Am A Strange Gloop. And that’s a title I had to come up with before I’d written the show. It’s about losing myself after having children and trying to get myself back. You might be thinking, but Sara, what’s it about? When my sister headbutted a stripper. Why Bruno Tonioli is my enemy. Football chants. Tom Hiddleston. People who dance on Instagram to do activism. If you’d like to come and see me, tickets are on sale now. You can go to my website, sarapascoe.co.uk to see a list of venues and to buy your tickets.”
