

Fixing trailer transcript

A clip plays of Natalie (Matt dressed in drag on stage) They say, "My name's Natalie, Natalie Spanner and we are going to have so much fun working together".

Text on screen reads 'A solo show performed by Natalie...and Matt'.

A clip plays of Matt on stage, he says "In my memory it's 1998 and me and Ruby are sitting on the back seat of the black beauty. That's Dad's car".

"Mum wasn't sure about letting us around the at first, after the divorce. Because Dad had torn up the kitchen floor, not sure why. And he's not put a new one down which means if you want to get across the kitchen you've got to walk a single gang plank like a pirate".

Another clip of Natalie plays, "So, the thing with breakdowns is we've all had them haven't we. But most of us weren't taught skills in proper maintenance at a young age".

"There are going to be a few points this evening where I'm going to ask some of you to get involved in some of the activities".

Natalie is stood on stage with a member of the audience. They say "And that's maintenance Archie. You're doing really well. Before you've even learnt to drive".

Matt is back on stage; we hear him saying "Expectations always feel a bit unplaceable with Dad actually. It's not something we talk about, which apparently is not that unusual for lots of fathers and sons".

A close shot of Natalie holding a steering wheel is seen on screen. They say, "Steer into it and there's a chance you'll steer out of it".

Natalie is on stage saying, "I needed to know how things worked, how they fit together, what makes them tick, what happens inside, how do things get broken and how are they fixed".

"And if you're ever feeling just a little bit flat, remember these words. Headlamps up, holistic car care, going on a journey together".
