

# Locomotive for Murder: The Improvised Whodunnit: Trailer

---

[Audio: Fast-paced, upbeat and jazzy music plays throughout the video]

Five actors stand on stage in front of a wooden train. One lies on the floor with arms spread wide. The others look shocked or avert their gaze. Each actor wears a different costume.

There are three male actors. One has a grey suit on, one has a patterned robe, and the other has aviator hat, goggles and a leather jacket on. There are two female actors, one has a hat, glasses, checkered scarf and a long brown skirt. The other has a furry brown jacket and a navy skirt.

The male actor with goggles pauses, shows a face of understanding, and drinks from an empty position bottle labelled, 'Truth'.

The male actor in a patterned robe hugs a woman in a long furry coat. She smiles warmly.

The female actor in a maid outfit stands holding suitcases, looking dissatisfied. To the far right, the male actor in the patterned robe stands at the back smiling with his hands clasped. The male actor with goggles stares at the maid, both watching her unimpressed expression. An empty chair sits nearby.

A wide shot shows all actors on stage looking out at the audience.

The male actor in a patterned robe appears behind a window, fabric wrapped around his neck, hands reaching outward.

A series of clips play including the female actor in a maid outfit reading a brown note, the female actor in a furry coat sitting on a chair reading a brown note, the male actor in a patterned robe reading a brown note while holding a cigar pipe and the male actor in goggles reading a brown note.

The male actor in a suit, now wearing a hat and trench coat, appears as a detective and tips his hat.

The female actor in a furry coat lies on the ground with eyes and mouth open, one hand stretched outward.

Four actors appear on stage as text fades in:

[Text: A fully improvised murder mystery!]

[Audio: “Welcome aboard the Locomotive for Murder.”]

The male actor in a suit lifts one leg off the ground before collapsing flat to the floor. All actors gather on stage. The female actor wearing a long skirt, hat and checkered scarf, points at the suited man’s body. All other actors stare at him.

[Audio: “Final callers, is there truth?”]

A panoramic shot reveals the female actor in a furry coat, the patterned jacket holding a cigar, and the goggle wearing actor.

[Audio: “One of you here must have done it.”]

The male actor in a trench coat tips his hat toward the audience.

[Audio: “Thinking cap on, detectives.”]

All actors sit: the male actor in goggles, the male actor in the patterned robe, the suited man, the female actor with hat and glasses and the female actor in furry coat.

[Audio: “Because I’m going to need all the help I can get.”]

A male actor wears a hat, furry scarf and suede jacket and a woman in a hat appears on the phone. A male actor in a suit and the man in the patterned robe dance together, stepping back and forward with hands spread out. The actor in the patterned robe kneels while holding the hand of the woman in the furry coat. He asks her a question.

[Audio: “Will you be my wife and marry me?”]

The female actor wearing glasses, a hat, and a checkered scarf holds out three tickets.

[Audio: “These tickets.”]

Three actors stare at her: the man with leather goggles and hat, the woman in the furry jacket, and the man in the patterned robe. All three grab a ticket.

A series of three clips play – one of the male actor with goggles, one with the male actor wearing a patterned robe and one wearing a military uniform. Each holds up a brown note labelled, ‘Guilty’.

[Audio: “It was me. It was me. It was me.”]

The female actor with glasses throws her hands out.

[Audio: "You have solved the Locomotive for Murder!"]

The male actors in goggles and patterned robe sit down.

All five actors bow to the audience while applause plays.

[Audio: "Get your tickets for Locomotive for Murder today. We've already got ours, but who will be innocent... and who will be guilty?"]

The male actor in the patterned robe appears holding a note that says, 'Innocent'. The female actor in the furry coat enters holding a note that says, 'Guilty'. The female actor with glasses is in the middle of both. All three stare into the camera in a close shot.
